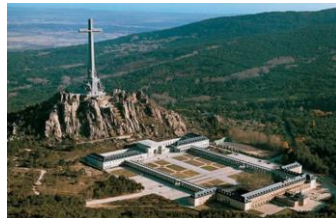


Research
